<p>Box 9 A. Your train journey is a journey full of adventures. You just left the station. On the way to your train compartment you encounter a difficult situation. A person refuses to stay in a train compartment because there are people of different ethnicities, because he says it bothers him. If the people involved in the conflict ask for your help, how could you solve this situation?</p>	<p>Box 10 A. You left the first train compartment and went to your seat. Now sit down and open the magazine from the table. You have reached the question box. In order to continue the game, you have to answer to at least one question from the next 3 questions (you can choose whatever question you want): What is social inclusion? What is social exclusion? What are the causes and effects of social exclusion?</p>
<p>Box 11 A. You start a discussion with a person from the train compartment. He politely asks you where you are going and where is the final destination. In this box you will have to identify what is your mission in this game, and what means the journey of discovery for your team. Discuss in your team for 3 minutes what you want to do in this journey of discovery and present it in the plenary in one minute - choose a leader that will present in plenary the summary of your discussions.</p>	<p>Box 12 A. Look out the window. You have reached box 12. Here is the answering box. Provide at least 5 examples of social inclusion.</p>
<p>Box 13 A. You have the pleasure to be on box 13 A, the bonus round. If you do this bonus round you will be able to advance directly to box 16A.</p> <p>Imagine a situation of discrimination towards a young person and imagine how you can solve the situation. Discuss in your team possible situations and create a role play based on it. Present in plenary the role play (maximum 4 minutes).</p>	<p>Box 14 A. You have reached box 14. Here is the answering box. Look out the window and you will see 2 people that mime something. Choose 2 people from the team who will mime. The rest of the team will have to guess what the 2 persons will mime.</p>
<p>Box 15 A. Think and tell a story of discrimination you have witnessed. Talk in your team for 5 minutes, then play the situation in the form of a role play. Choose a storyteller, a person who will describe what the rest of the team will play. The persons who plays the roles are not allowed to speak.</p>	<p>Box 16A. In your train compartment, a discussion about an anti-discrimination campaign started and a group of people want to start an anti-discrimination campaign. Join the discussion and help to create this campaign. Who is the campaign for? Choose a slogan for your campaign.</p>

<p>Box 17 A. You're hungry. You are getting ready to go eat in the train's restaurant. In order to enter you have to guess the password of the restaurant. The password is a word that describes social inclusion.</p> <p>If you can't guess, the facilitator will give you maximum 2 clues to help you guess. Each clue will make you lose a point, so next time you will roll the dice you will go as far the dice says minus the number of clues you received.</p>	<p>Box 18 A. Here, together with your travel companions from the train compartment, you will have to discuss freely in plenary about patterns of social inclusion you have heard in your community, or elsewhere. Be spontaneous and do this conversation freely. Let's hear you! You will have 5 minutes to discuss.</p>
<p>Box 19 A. We know that stereotypes are one of the causes of discrimination. Next, together with your travel companions from the train compartment, think for 5 minutes about at least one solution, through which the stereotypes could be eliminated. Create/ find the solution and think about its effects. You will have to present the solution to the big group. You can do this either by establishing a leader from the team that will have to present the solution or by playing a role play. Choose how you will do it and present it in 3 minutes.</p>	<p>Box 20 A. Here is the train first station. You remembered you forgot one of the suitcases in the train station where you left. Get off the train and return to box 9 so you can take the suitcase. TURN BACK!</p>
<p>Box 21 A. Take a break! The train will stop to wait for another train to pass. Take this opportunity and admire the surroundings.</p>	<p>Box 22 A. You thought you were about to continue the game, but apparently you are not. Rest and stay a turn (next time when is your turn to roll the dice you are not allowed too, pass the turn to the next team).</p>
<p>Box 23 A. The train stops to be powered. Metaphorically speaking, with what should our society needs to be fuelled in order to help the social inclusion and non-discrimination be a priority for all?</p>	<p>Box 24 A. On your train journey, a message is heard on the speaker before the next station. One person gets in the train and didn't had the chance to listen the entire message. If you were to reproduce the message in one phrase, what would it sound like? The message should contain the following words: discrimination, tolerance, stereotypes and exclusion.</p>
